## A Family Event

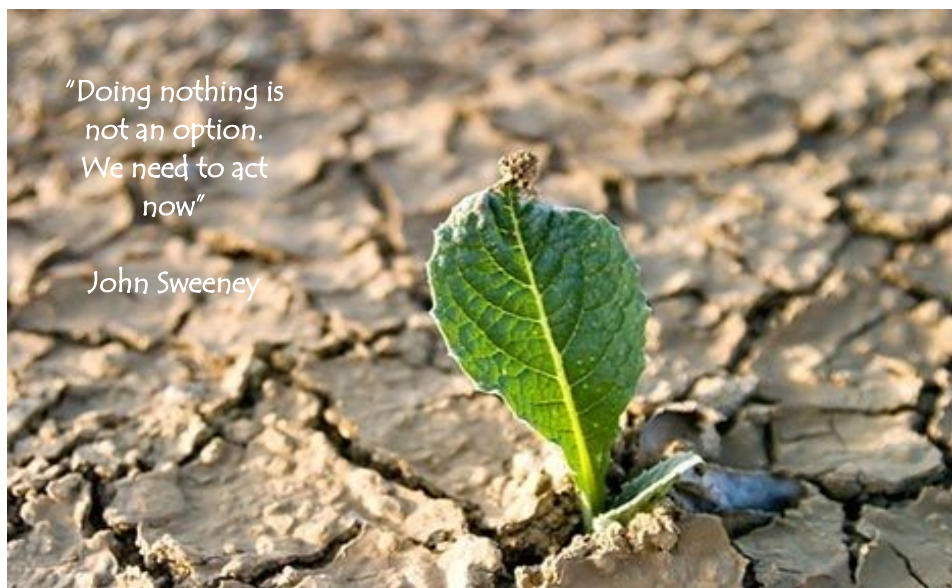
